## THE BLEEDING CONTROL BAG

Contained in a rugged nylon carry bag designed for everyone from a school resource officer to the general public, this multi pack life saving kit provides intuitive and easy-to-use tools with instructions that are proven to help save lives. One notable component of the kit is the Combat Application Tourniquet (CAT), which is the fastest, safest and most effective prehospital tourniquet in the world. Also included in the bag are quality gauze, shears and pressure dressings/bandages. Step-by-step illustrated "just in time" pictorial instructions are also contained in the bag, so even untrained providers can help save a life. The Kit also includes a portable stretcher, to help move the injured and make this kit a complete care device for both patient care and transport capability.

## THE BLEEDING CONTROL KIT

To address the need for a smaller and also a more mobile deployment two additional products have been added to the response assortment. First is the responder pack. This item is designed to be added to the First aid kit or "go bag". It provides a single response bleeding control option with Quick Clot included just like the Multipack above.

## BLEEDING CONTROL POUCH

The third option was a basic configuration developed to be placed in AED Cabinets and arrives in a manufacturers sealed plastic bag that is placed alongside the AED. This merging of AED and bleeding control has been a natural fit for schools and business to to create a centralized access for other medical and traumatic emergencies.
